- Cobblestones around St. Stephen's but manageable with cane or a stroller

Theme: Medieval charm and riverside relaxation

Transport Mode:

- Morning: Scenic Danube River Cruise (1.5 hours) from Vienna to Bratislava (timetable dependent)
- Comfortable seating, toilets onboard, no stairs
- Alternative: 1-hour private transfer by car with luggage handling

Key Attractions:

- Bratislava Castle
- Take the castle shuttle or elevator to top; views over Danube
- Old Town walking tour (1 hour)
- Flat terrain, benches throughout
- Blue Church (St. Elizabeth) – Art Nouveau dream with photo ops

Meal Stops:

- **Lunch:** [Modrá Hviezda](#) – Local Slovak food near the castle, terrace seating
- **Dinner:** [Zylinder Café](#) – Austro-Hungarian cuisine with elegant indoor/outdoor seating. Vegetarian friendly

Cultural Highlights:

- Crafts and souvenirs in Hviezdoslav Square
- Optional: Small folk museum or Slovak Philharmonic mini-concert

Accessibility Notes:

- Most of Old Town is pedestrian-only and flat

Castle has paved paths and an elevator

Basic phrases in German, Slovak, Hungarian

Bonus Senior Travel Tips:

- Free public toilets are available in museums and restaurants – plan stops accordingly
- Senior travel discounts (typically 60+) on local transit and tours – carry your passport
- Currency:
 - Austria & Slovakia: Euros
 - Hungary: Forint (but many places accept card or Euros)
- Drink tap water in all 3 countries – clean and safe

Day 3 Continued: Budapest, Hungary 🇭🇺

Meal Stops:

Lunch: [Café Gerbeaud](#) – Iconic dessert café with historic ambiance and large restrooms

Dinner: [Hungarikum Bistro](#) – Traditional Hungarian food, reservation recommended

Cultural Highlights:

- Evening Danube Cruise with Lights (7 PM)
1-hour ride, relaxing views of illuminated bridges and Parliament

Optional Activity:

- Széchenyi Thermal Baths (3–6 PM)
Senior-friendly pools, dressing cabins, and shallow entry zones – Ideal for muscle relief and jet lag recovery

Accessibility Notes:

- Budapest trams have wheelchair access (especially Line 2 by the river)
- Thermal bath has non-slip floors, handrails, and assisted changing if needed

Day 3: Budapest, Hungary 🇭🇺

Theme: Thermal healing and grand architecture

Transport Mode:

- Morning: 2–2.5-hour private car transfer from Bratislava to Budapest
(rest stop and scenic countryside views included)

Key Attractions:

- Buda Castle & Fisherman's Bastion
Funicular or shuttle bus to the top; accessible paths
- St. Stephen's Basilica
Elevator access to panoramic dome for spectacular views
- Danube River Promenade & Parliament Viewpoint
